






"CAN WE BE GOOD WITHOUT GOD?"

MORAL ARGUMENT





Therefore, God exists.









VALUES

"Good" or "Bad"

 \rightarrow worth

"Right" or "Wrong"

→ obligation









Facts

Person-independent

Examples:

- Laws of nature
- Statistical data





Opinions

Person-dependent

Examples:

- · Taste in movies, music, etc.
- Pain tolerance



REALITY

Ontology

The real existence of right and wrong.

Example:

If the Nazis had won WWI...



Epistemology

The way we come to know what is right or wrong.

Examples:

- · Revelation through scripture
- Moral intuition
- Personal experience

Euthyphro Dilemma

Does God will something because it is good?



Is something good because God wills it?

DILEMMA: a situation in which one is forced to choose between two problematic options

Euthyphro Dilemma solved















