






CRITERIA FOR AUTHENTICITY



HISTORICAL FIT

The incident fits in known historical facts of the time and place.



INDEPENDENT, EARLY SOURCES

The incident is related in multiple sources, which are near to the time when the incident is said to have occurred and which don't rely on each other or on a common source.



EMBARASSMENT

The incident is awkward or unproductive for the early Christian church.



DISSIMILARITY

The incident is unlike earlier Jewish ideas and/or unlike later Christian ideas.



SEMITISMS

Traces of Hebrew or Aramaic language (spoken by Jesus' countrymen) appear in the story.




COHERENCE

The incident fits in with the facts already established about Jesus.
